Requesting Leave and Absences

- Leave is only authorized once requested through a request form available on the <u>website</u>, or in the Ship's Office. Cadets who do not request leave will be considered absent without authority (AWOL). Attendance is used to determine eligibility for special events including summer camps.
- 9. Cadets who require more than 3 weeks of consecutive leave must request to be excused drill and training. This is done through a cadet's divisional officer, and a substantial reason must be provided.
- 10. Cadets who fail to request leave for four (4) consecutive weeks are considered non-effective and will be released from the cadet program.
