Part 2: GENERAL ITEMS

Winter Weather Statement

 As we enter the winter months, the risk of adverse weather affecting training increases. If training has to be cancelled due to weather, we will make the announcement on Facebook and Instagram. Cadets without access to either of these should inquire through their divisional system. Regardless if training is cancelled or not, if anyone deems it unsafe to travel to cadets due to the condition of the roads, simply send us a message through the corps website for the absence to be excused.

Training

 Any significant changes to the schedule will be communicated through a letter, email or phone call. The <u>Facebook page</u> and <u>Corps website</u> will also be updated regularly. Biathlon Competition

OSLA Band Clinic

4. An area band clinic will be held at Connaught 29-30 January. Training will be from 0800-1630 Saturday and 0800-1400 Sunday. Lunch is provided. Cadets who had indicated their desire to attend are registered.

Holiday Stand Down

5. There will be no training on 25 December and 1 Jan. We will return to regular training on Tuesday 8 January.

Annul Mess Dinner

6. One of our corps' oldest traditions is an annual mess dinner before the holidays. We follow the form of a traditional naval mess dinner, and as a reward for their hard work since September, the officers will be serving the cadets. This years' dinner will be held Tuesday, 11 December at the Kanata Branch of the Royal Canadian Legion, 70 Hines Road. It will take place during regular training times. This is a sponsored dinner, so cadets who indicate that they will attend are required to be there.

Requesting Leave and Absences

- Leave is only authorized once requested through a request form available on the <u>website</u>, or in the Ship's Office. Cadets who do not request leave will be considered absent without authority (AWOL). Attendance is used to determine eligibility for special events including summer camps.
- 8. Cadets who require more than 3 weeks of consecutive leave must request to be excused drill and training. This is done through a cadet's divisional officer, and a substantial reason must be provided.
- 9. Cadets who fail to request leave for four (4) consecutive weeks are considered non-effective and will be released from the cadet program.

Wearing the Cadet Uniform

- 10. Cadets are only authorized to wear their uniforms at cadet events and travelling directly to and from those events.
- 11. Cadets who wish to wear their uniforms to other events (Remembrance services at school, funerals, weddings etc...) must submit a request form to their Divisional Officer. Cadets may wear their uniforms to these events after permission has been given by the Commanding Officer.
