#### Part 2: GENERAL ITEMS

#### **Winter Weather Statement**

Regardless if training is cancelled or not, if anyone deems it unsafe to travel to cadets due to the condition of the roads, simply send us a message through the corps website for the absence to be excused.

#### **Training**

2. Any significant changes to the schedule will be communicated through a letter, email or phone call. The <a href="Facebook page">Facebook page</a> and <a href="Corps website">Corps website</a> will also be updated regularly. DPOs will contact their cadets. In the event of any discrepancy, please refer to the Facebook page, as it is the easiest to keep up to date in a timely manner.

#### **March Break Trip**

3. The information about the March Break Trip to Washington/Virginia has been distributed. If you require additional information, please ask through your divisional staff. **Deposits are due by February 12.** 

#### **Navy League Medal of Excellence**

4. Recommendations for the Navy League Medal of Excellence are due in Toronto by February 15. Cadets interested in being considered for this medal must submit a personal resume and a 1-2 page biography of their cadet experience. These documents are due to the corps by **February 12**.

#### **PD Opportunity**

5. A professional development day will be hosted by OSLA on 2 March. This will take place at Connaught and will feature a variety of speakers on several topics. There is room for 3 senior cadets and 3 officers per unit. Lunch will be provided. Availability must be communicated to the XO by **February 12**. Unused spaces will be passed along to other units.

## **Cadet Summer Training Applications**

1. Applications for summer camp course are now available. Forms and information sheets are available in the office. Applications are due by **February 26**. Late applications will not be accepted.

#### **Requesting Leave and Absences**

- 2. Leave is only authorized once requested through a request form available on the <u>website</u>, or in the Ship's Office. Cadets who do not request leave will be considered absent without authority (AWOL). Attendance is used to determine eligibility for special events including summer camps.
- 3. Cadets who require more than 3 weeks of consecutive leave must request to be excused drill and training. This is done through a cadet's divisional officer, and a substantial reason must be provided.

4. Cadets who fail to request leave for four (4) consecutive weeks are considered non-effective and will be released from the cadet program.

## **Wearing the Cadet Uniform**

- 5. Cadets are only authorized to wear their uniforms at cadet events and travelling directly to and from those events.
- 6. Cadets who wish to wear their uniforms to other events (Remembrance services at school, funerals, weddings etc...) must submit a request form to their Divisional Officer. Cadets may wear their uniforms to these events after permission has been given by the Commanding Officer.
